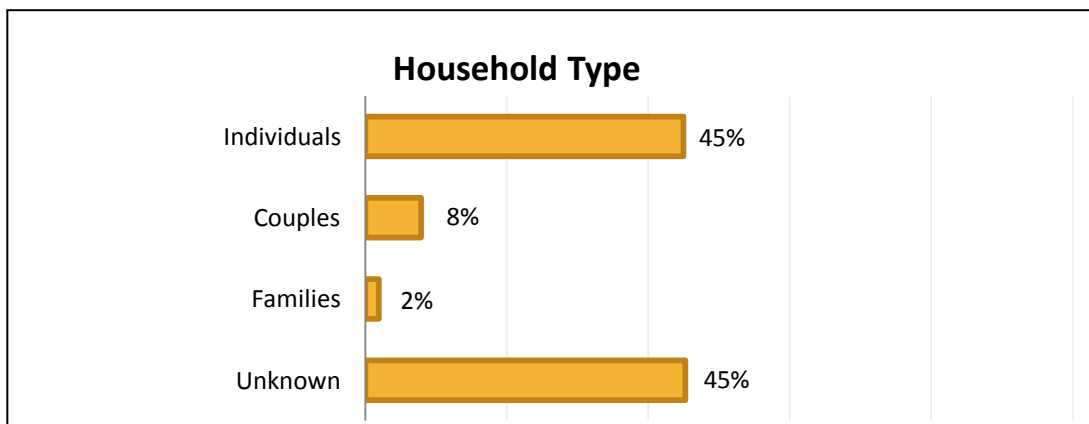
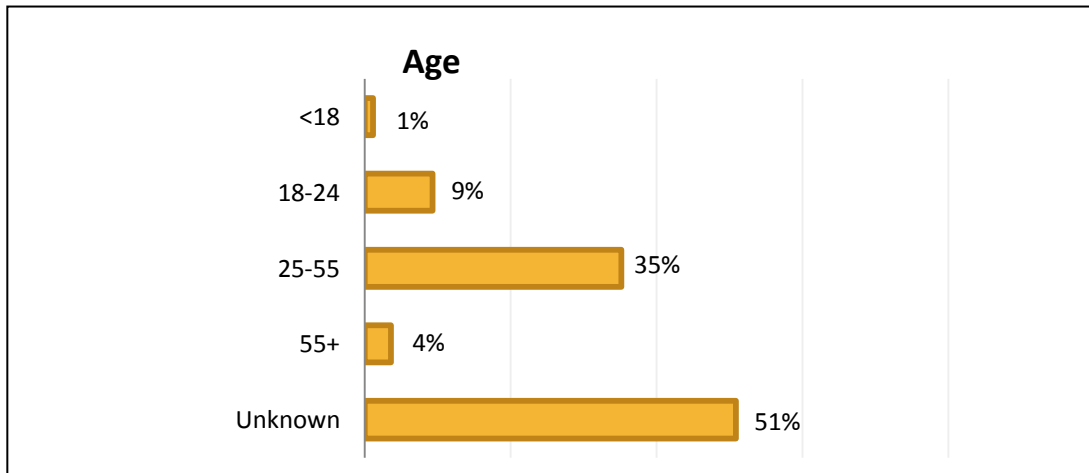
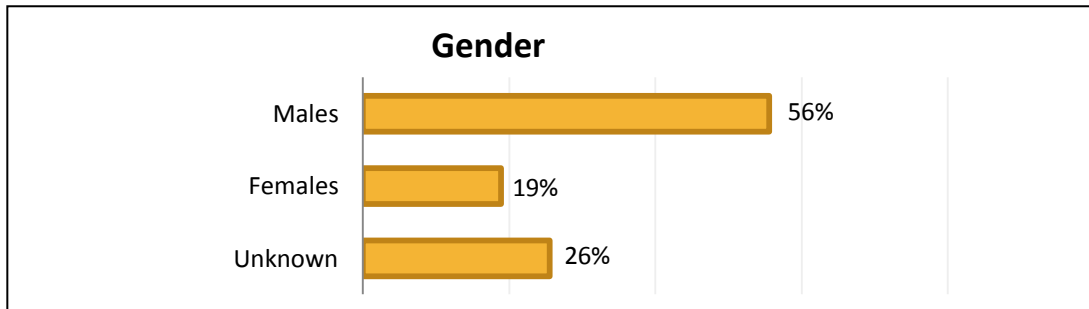


Additional Street Count Data on Unidentified Individuals

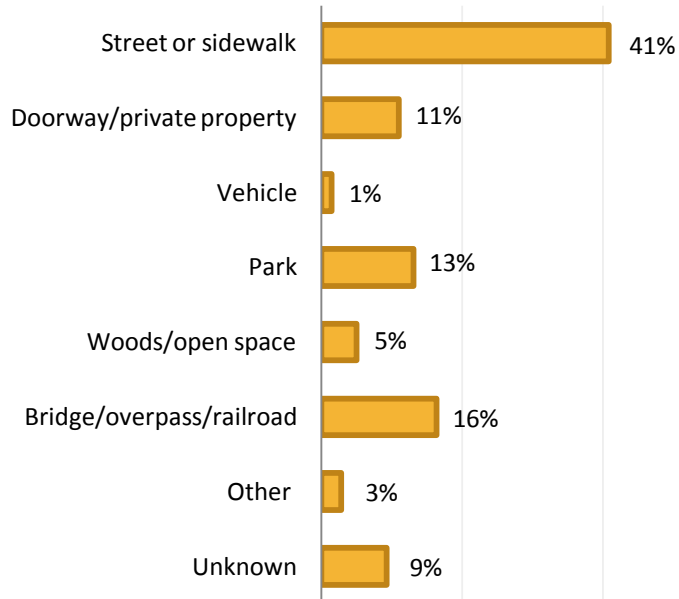
The Street Count data only includes information collected on people who provided basic identifying information (first three letters of last name, first letter of first name, age, and gender), making it possible to verify that their data was not duplicated. An additional 635 unsheltered people were documented during the Street Count who did not provide identifying information. This includes people whom outreach workers did not wish to disturb while sleeping, who were camped in sites that outreach workers could not enter, or who were seen camping out but refused to participate in the survey. It also includes people who verified that they were homeless and unsheltered on the night of the count but were not willing to share their identifying information.

Due to the lack of identifying information, it is impossible to know what portion of the 635 people might have also been included in the official Street Count number, or the extent to which there may be duplication within the 635 figure.
