Use a blue or black pen.



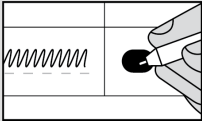
Rank candidates in the order of your choice.



Do not fill in more than one oval in a rank column.



Do not fill in more than one oval in a candidate row.



To add a candidate who is not on the ballot, write the candidate's name on the write-in line and fill in an oval to rank them.
