# What is complementary & alternative medicine?



#### Chiropractic

Chiropractic and manual manipulation of the spine or other parts of the body is a non-invasive therapy that focuses on reducing pain and improving the function and structure of the body.



Naturopathic Medicine

Naturopathic medicine uses a wide range of natural approaches, such as clinical nutrition, herbal medicine, and homeopathy to diagnose and treat patients.



#### **Massage Therapy**

Therapeutic massage involves the manipulation of the soft tissue structures of the body to help prevent and alleviate pain, muscle discomfort, muscle spasms, and stress.



#### Acupuncture

Acupuncture is the stimulation of specific points on the body by the insertion of thin metal needles through the skin. Patients rely on acupuncture treatments to relieve pain and reduce inflammation.
