

SUN SERVICE SYSTEM RFP PROPOSAL QUESTION STRUCTURE

I. REGIONAL SERVICES

If proposing to serve more than one region, a separate stand-alone proposal must be submitted for each.

Part A. Organizational Qualification and Capacity

- 4-5 questions about the organization's ability and capacity to provide the chosen services, which may include questions about:
 - Knowledge, skills, familiarity with the Region/Population
 - Experience
 - Staffing and retention
 - Administrative model
- 4 questions about the organization's ability to provide services in a Culturally Responsive manner.
- 1-2 questions about the organization's sustainability practices.

Part B. Programmatic Questions

- 2 questions plus a scenario relating to the organization's ability to provide services in each of the following areas:
 - SUN Community Schools;
 - SUN Youth Advocacy Program;
 - SUN Parent-Child Development Services; AND
 - Multnomah Stability Initiative and Energy and Utility Assistance

II. CULTURALLY SPECIFIC SERVICES

If proposing to serve more than one population/service area, a separate stand-alone proposal must be submitted for each.

Part A. Organizational Qualification and Capacity

- 4-5 questions about the organization's ability and capacity to provide the chosen services, which may include questions about:
 - Knowledge, skills, familiarity with the Region/Population
 - Experience
 - Staffing and retention
 - Administrative model
- 4 questions about the organization's ability to provide services in a Culturally Responsive manner.
- 1-2 questions about the organization's sustainability practices.

Part B. Culturally Specific Services Qualification Questions

- 3-4 Questions relating to the characteristics of organizations that are qualified to provide Culturally Specific Services
- NOTE:** The Proposer must score **AT LEAST 70%** in this section to be considered for an award.

Part C. Programmatic Questions

- 2 questions plus a scenario relating to the organization's ability to provide services to the specific population in the specific service area chosen.

Part D. Culturally Specific Services Subcontractor Qualification

- Only required if proposing as a Lead Agency.
 - 3-4 Questions relating to the subcontractor's ability to provide Culturally Specific Services.
- NOTE:** The subcontractor/s must score **AT LEAST 70%** in this section for the Lead Agency to be considered for an award.

III. COUNTYWIDE SERVICES

If proposing to serve more than one countywide service area, a separate stand-alone proposal must be submitted for each.

Part A. Organizational Qualification and Capacity

- 4-5 questions about the organization's ability and capacity to provide the chosen services, which may include questions about:
 - Knowledge, skills, familiarity with the Region/Population
 - Experience
 - Staffing and retention
 - Administrative model
- 4 questions about the organization's ability to provide services in a Culturally Responsive manner.
- 1-2 questions about the organization's sustainability practices.

Part B. Programmatic Questions

- 4 questions plus a scenario relating to the organization's ability to provide services to the specific service area chosen.
Choose ONE (1) Service Area
- SUN Youth Substance Abuse Prevention Services

• Sexual and Gender Minority Youth Services
