DETERMINATION THAT PROSPECTIVE INITIATIVE PETITION MEETS CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENTS

After consulting with the County Attorney's office, it is my determination that the attached Initiative Petition filed January 29, 2016, by Peter Zuckerman, meets the single subject requirements of the Oregon Constitution and Metro Charter relative to the initiative and referendum power.

Attached is the Prospective Initiative Petition for you to generate a ballot title and explanatory statement. That ballot title and explanatory statement should be returned to us no later than February 12, 2016. A copy should also be sent to the Chief Petitioner. After receipt of the ballot title and explanatory statement, our office will then provide public notice, giving electors up to seven business days to challenge the title and explanatory statement in Circuit Court.
