- Be willing to make mistakes and be accountable for missteps
- Move up, move back - elevate your participation, elevate your reflection
- Work within the energy, availability, and abilities that you have to support each other in additional CIC tasks, as needed.

- Discuss ideas not people: dialogue not debate
