Long Term Care Assessment Notice Private Pay Residents

(MCAR 023-080-225) Before admitting a private paying resident, the Operator shall advise the potential resident, his/her family, or his/her legal representative of the right to receive a long term care assessment. The Operator shall certify on a form provided by the ACHP that the individual has been so advised. Upon admission, the Operator shall maintain a copy of the form in the resident records.

This form must be completed prior to admission to an Adult Care Home

To Resident and/or Family Members:

Oregon law requires you be notified of your care options, when considering admission to an Adult Care Home, Resident Care Facility, Assisted Living Facility and non-Medicaid Nursing Facility.

Counseling options can help you identify your long term care needs and provide you with information about different care settings and services available to meet your needs.

The recommendations you receive are not binding, you may choose any option.

Counseling options is available at your own expense through private agencies certified by the State or at no charge from Multnomah County Department of County Human Services - Aging, Disability Veterans Services Division.
