Department solicitation and Department or Division description:

The Division of Assessment, Recording and Taxation is seeking qualified candidates for a temporary position in the Industrial Appraisal section. Oregon Revised Statutes requires the assessor to assess the value of all taxable property each year.

Job Task Description:

This position will work on a project to identify and catalogue cell tower and communication sites in Multnomah County. Through coordination with the GIS/Parcel Management team this position will explore the synthesis between cutting edge GIS technology and appraisal techniques to solve valuation issues. Tasks will include field inspections, database/spreadsheet editing, and taking measurements and/or photographs. The position will gather, review and organize preliminary communication site records and develop and maintain a database of these property records. The position also may assist in data analysis for valuation of properties.

Knowledge/Skills/Abilities Required:

- Excel and GIS skills
- Data research and analysis
- Critical Thinking- Using logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems.
- Effective verbal and communication skills.
- Ability to use mobile field device
- Time Management- managing one's own time to complete both office and field work in timely, complete and accurate manner.
