Agency solicitation and Program Description:

The Multnomah County Sheriff's Office is seeking qualified candidates for a temporary, summer position as an Office Assistant in our Close Street Supervision (CSS) Program. Close Street is an intensive custody and supervision program that provides pre-trial services to arrestees of Measure 11 crimes, domestic violence cases, and a select group of clients with mental health disorders. Deputies interview defendants and conduct investigations to present the Court with accurate, timely, and impartial information which assists the Judge in making an informed release decision. This program supports both offender accountability and reentry of the offender into the community while increasing available jail beds.

Job Description:

This position will assist the CSS personnel in administrative duties to include entering data into a case management system, running statistical and other reports to assist deputies in release recommendations. Retrieve data from phone system used by clients to "check in" and enter data in case management system.
