


- ~196,000 residents

People of Color



Poverty Rate



- Advocate for substantial transportation investment in neglected areas.
- Fight to increase pedestrian safety in high risk corridors, with a focus on pushing the community to meet its Vision Zero goals.
- Lead Multnomah County in sustainability and environmental justice.
- Create more economic opportunity in East Portland.

First 90 Days





- Sponsored proclamation on importance of ACA
- Publically spoke out against Trump's racist and hateful immigration and refugee Executive
 Orders
- Allocated \$100,000 to education, outreach, and legal defense services for immigrant community
- Testified at City Council in favor of reduced speed on Outer Division
- Hosted first District 3 Constituent Coffee

Multnomah County Budget

- \$1.88 Billion annual budget (\$500M in General Fund)
- 2% reductions for most agencies in FY18
- Priority: preserving existing services and expanding where possible.
