
The Problem:

- Many individuals who seek treatment for alcohol and drug disorders are unable to keep their first treatment appointment
- The average wait tolerance of individuals waiting drug treatment is one month.
 40% drop off a waiting list within two weeks
- Generally, individuals who waited 30 days to enter care were half as likely to complete four sessions of outpatient care




The Problem: Delayed Recovery

 60-70% of individuals who began care within 7 days completed four sessions of care



Here's How It Works:







- Ensures appropriate treatment at the most receptive time
- Links immediately to person who will coordinate care
- Offers personal touch to anyone choosing recovery
- First point of contact for treatment that will track and report all state documentation



The Bottom Line:



- Delays in access to treatment lead to worse outcomes
- Reducing delay will improve chance for recovery
