Program Description

The Passport Program processes, reviews, and accepts customers' passport applications, maintaining standards set by the federal government. Multhomah County Passport agents then submit accepted applications to the federal government. Customers work directly with trained passport agents, who act as intermediaries between the public and the federal government. To fulfill this responsibility, the Department of State requires agents to undergo specialized training and to renew their certification annually. Application services are available to any US citizen, and the program serves any citizen inside or outside Multhomah County. This program is available by appointment or same-day appointment service.

The Photo I.D. Program serves internal staff and the public. For internal staff, the Photo Program generates over 4,000 new and replacement badges per year. For external customers, the program serves customers seeking passport photos.

Both programs strive to provide excellent customer service to stakeholders.
