**Heroes Inspiring Leadership, Learning,
Teamwork, Opportunity and Pride (HILLTOP)**

**Multnomah County Commission for Economic Dignity
Youth and Family Services Division
Department of County Human Service**

Purpose: To recognize and reward “local heroes” – individuals, consumers, public officials, or organizations – who make a positive difference in the lives of people living on a low income and impacted communities in Multnomah County.

HILLTOP Award Categories:

1. **Individual Achievement** – Given to an individual who has transitioned out of poverty and has assisted other people living on a low income to pursue personal goals and self-sufficiency. We encourage nominations of youth, elders, persons with disabilities, and those of culturally/ethnically diverse backgrounds.
2. **Agency Staff / Volunteer Achievement** – Given to an agency staff or volunteer who has demonstrated extraordinary capacity and caring in helping individuals, families and communities to resolve the issue of poverty. This work can have taken place in a variety of settings or with a diversity of population groups – youth, elders, people with disabilities, and families.
3. **Public Official Achievement** – Given to an elected or appointed official who has made an outstanding contribution to public policy in support of low-income community development or programs to assist low-income individuals and families at the local, State or Federal level.

**Nominations for the 2018 Hilltop Awards must be submitted
by midnight on Monday, May 28th to be considered.**

A selection committee comprised of the MCCED members will meet to review submissions and select winners. The HILLTOP Awards will be presented at Multnomah County’s Annual Volunteer Award Ceremony on June 26th at 5:30 PM in the County Board Room in the Multnomah Building, Located at 501 SE Hawthorne Blvd., Portland Oregon.

2. Agency Staff / Volunteer Achievement

Staff or volunteers with non-profit or community-based organizations are eligible.

3. Public Official Achievement

Elected or appointed officials who have demonstrated leadership in planning or public policy efforts to address the needs of communities impacted by poverty. Nominees may also have lead efforts to improve or enhance government social services in support of low-income consumers.

a. How has the public official demonstrated leadership to address the issue of poverty in our community?
