

Evaluation Review Process

The County will develop a department level strategic framework that includes:

- System indicators to inform **service** provision
- Relevant **outcomes**
- And demonstrates relationship to population **impact**.

May involve the revision of program models and identified outcomes

Process began with SUN Youth Advocacy this Fall.



SUN Youth Advocacy (SYA) Process

1. Workgroup of folks from SYA programs (Sept-Nov)
 - Main working group consists of ~18 folks who are SYA supervisors and staff
 - 3 work group meetings to outline a complete draft of full theory of change visual model
2. Feedback from participating youth and SUN Data and Results Advisory Group (Nov/Dec.)
3. Final workgroup meeting in early 2018 to incorporate the feedback and complete the model.



Emerging Findings

1. An overall advocacy framework emerged which reflects 1:1 youth meetings, group skill development, and collaborative advocacy
2. Many of the main outcomes that we currently collect came through strongly in the process (academic achievements, expulsion/suspension, on track credits, etc.)
3. **Positive Cultural Identity Development & Self-Efficacy** (ie: self-advocacy, engaged in community, preparing for the future, overall maturity/confidence) **were key youth outcomes added to the model.**



Emerging Findings, cont.

4. Additional outcomes specifically related to the collaborative advocacy work were identified:
 - Family Empowerment
 - Quality collaborations with school staff/partner agency
