OSSCC State of Safe Schools Report

Key Findings

- Positive youth development is on the decline
- Bullying, intimidation, harassment and threats of violence
- Fear based absences and chronic absences
- Suicidal ideation and suicide attempts
- Sexual coercion and sexual assault

Recommendations

- Trained and supportive educators and other supportive adults/service providers
- Trauma-informed classrooms
- Inclusive curriculum across content areas
- Supportive student affinity clubs
- Enumerated anti-bullying policies
