Desired Outcomes for the Meeting:

- Identify strategic activities for Emerging Issues Action Area: Youth Experience of Belonging,
 Safety and Bullying
- Review and input into draft FY19 work plan
- Prioritization of additional information to collect to support telling the SUN Story
- Continue to deepen relationship building by increasing connection and trust amongst members

I. Welcome and Introductions (10 min)

- Frank shares any opening remarks and welcomes Judy as Co-Chair.
- Judy opening remarks
- Frank ask folks to do a quick round of introductions as there are a few newer members. We will being doing community building activity later in agenda. <u>Start</u> <u>with Kim</u> to update on Chair's seat and announce Nicole Buchanan joining the county a policy advisor

II. Recap and Reflections on August Retreat (15 min)

- Show retreat capture slideshow (briefly summarize what happened)
 - Frank cover slides 1-6 reminded ourselves of SUN theory of change and lane; desired retreat outcomes; aspirations for the system and motivation to stay involved provided foundation for the day
 - Judy cover slides 7-11 dug in to what we like to include when we tell the story of SUN and what additional info would help tell it; had a good opportunity to work on action planning for the system in 5 areas. Did individual table work throughout the session and then a world café review at the end.
 - o Diana share written feedback/capture of the input; materials on tables
- Ask for reflections from the group.
- Frank and Judy offer any reflections. Some ideas:
 - Rich conversations and opportunity to connect around what maintains our commitment to the SUN collaboration.

- Recognition that we have a lot of turnover at multiple levels in the system;
 folks lack sense of the history, benefits and opportunities
- Around the SUN story there was a lot of energy around capturing more of the story of SUN as we talk about it; having council members and other in the system feel prepared to tell the story - have easy talking points.
- Youth experience data and conversation stood out particularly around the SF2020 work with Reynolds - lots of questions and ideas for action were generated

III. Deeper Planning Dive: Youth Experience of Safety, Belonging and Bullying (60 min)

- Frank offer context: why we are deep diving on this one
 - We feel a level of urgency to respond to youth voices and there was a lot of interest at the retreat in identifying ways to use the SUN partnership and system to work on the issue of belonging, safety and bullying, with a focus on racism
 - Is an area that includes several of our action areas in one system alignment, youth voice/engagement
- Diana share 8 ideas for activities that emerged from retreat
- Small groups Diana facilitate
 - Each group further develop 4 activities (one chart pak per activitiy) (10-15) - Diana and Peggy do note taking for the groups
 - Swap and make additions to other 4 (10)
- Community Building Break (10)
 - Peggy leads Mingle, mingle 3 rounds
 - What do you like to bring to a potluck?
 - What's your dream job?
 - What's something about you folks would never figure out?
- Diana sets up small group 2x2 activity with all 8 activities using impact and influence/control as the axes place post its on 2x2 chart pak (10-15)
- Diana combine 2x2s and reflect on results what rises to top? Consensus on one or two to pursue? A few members willing to work with staff on developing next steps? (5)

IV. Review Draft Action Plan (30)

- Diana orient council to draft action plan document (5)
- Peggy discuss hone messaging & conduct outreach action area (15)
 - Discuss plan for messaging development
 - Input into priority level of additional information to be collected have worksheet - circle items that feel are critical for them to tell the story and they feel certain they would use information - turn in sheets at end
 - Solicit any additional input into hone messaging action area & next steps
 - Judy open small group discussion and input into other action areas (10)

- Our intention is to have a deeper discussion at the November meeting about System Alignment and whether there is a meaningful action around new funding.
- For today, just asking if folks have any reactions or input we should note.
- Staff will update this document and distribute with notes.

V Next Steps (5)

- Frank recaps any actions and commitments (anyone volunteer to help with further framing the youth experience work) and reminds folks of November meeting: November 2, 2018, 9:00-11:00am at MESD
- For the November meeting, are there any suggestions for SUN partners we should reach out to who might have youth experience information to share?
- Also, we have several vacant alternate spots due to member transitions. Would like to get these filled this fall. Diana will be following up with members where we have a vacant alternate spot to identify alternates in the next month.

Plan for Messaging Development (for Peggy's part)

- Matt Kinshella develop one-page visual and frame for a core set of talking points for use by council and others incorporate things folks identified they want to talk about including collective impact, the "u" in SUN. Possibly use the "Story of us, me and now" frame [by early October]
- Decision about which additional data points to gather [Sept council meeting]
- SUN staff gather additional data and information to help folks tell specific stories [September-October and possibly ongoing]
- Vet frame and points with council co-chairs [early-mid October]
- Develop set of materials and guidance/roles for council outreach visits to leaders Matt and Diana [October?]
- Practice time for all council members; identify core set of members who will be quarterbacks for visits [November council meeting]
