The City of Gresham expects that Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME) funds will be available; Multnomah County expects to have CDBG funds available for potential housing and community development projects in fiscal year 2019-2020.

The County's primary goals of the program are to enhance viable communities, public facilities improvements, assist with housing rehabilitation and provide funds for public services. The City of Gresham, in addition to providing CDBG funding for the same type of projects, will also provide funding to the development of appropriate affordable housing, economic development, assist first-time homebuyers and provide limited funds for public services.

Workshop topics will include estimated availability of funds, the application and selection process and application criteria. Application packets, criteria and schedules will be available at the workshop. The City of Gresham pre-application is due January 23, 2019 at 5:00pm; applications are due February 15, 2019 at 5:00pm. Multnomah County applications are due at 4:30 p.m. on Friday, February 15, 2019. Funding will be available after July 1, 2019.
