What to Ask Before Adopting a Risk Assessment Tool

The following is a guideline for criminal justice professionals and institutions who are considering adopting a risk assessment tool. It is important that your institution is able to answer and understand the answers to these questions before a new tool is implemented. Be aware that in the process of answering these questions you may find that the risk tool you are considering is not actually suitable to your client population or your institutional goals. To answer some of these questions, you may need to contact the institution or company which developed the risk assessment.
