Program Description

Built in 1985 and purchased by Multnomah County in 1999, the Multnomah Building includes office space for the County's elected officials and many administrative divisions, and includes the County's Board of Commissioners room where public meetings are held throughout the year. Currently, the first floor of the building offers multi-stall gendered restrooms but lacks an all-gender option for public use.

This Program Offer includes design and construction services to convert a room adjacent to the Board of Commissioners room that is currently used as office space into an all-gender, ADA accessible single stall restroom. The renovation provides an equitable and accessible option for County staff and the public.
