- Service gaps: Money/reimbursement rates, African American Services, Cross-training for mental health and substance use, staff retention, lack of training, diverse mentors, residential for MAT clients, housing, transitional housing/stabilization, collaboration between providers, POC (especially Native Americans) in field, claim reimbursement, types of money/funding stipulations, kids not being returned from foster care due to housing instability, lack of outcomes analysis, culturally-specific services, more efficiency with overhead costs so more funding for direct client services, contracting with Care Oregon, make billing easier and more efficient, a place where father can have their children in treatment.
