

SJC // About the Safety + Justice Challenge



Pretrial system assessment:

- October 2019 December 2019
- Results presented: January 2020
- Conducted by Justice System Partners (JSP)

Assessment will include:

- Status of multi-agency collaboration for pretrial system oversight (e.g., establishment of release-detention framework/guidelines, use of performance measures to improve system's functioning)
- Role of the prosecution and defense in pretrial decision-making
- Court pretrial decision-making
- Roles of DCJ and Sheriff's Pre-trial programs
- Pretrial system, including performance measurement and reporting
