	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Law was scheduled to go into effect on 10/15/19 that would make public charge a criteria that could be used to deny permission to enter the US or become a permanent resident. ○ Several US District Courts filed orders stating DHS can't enforce this rule under the Immigration & Nationality Act – effectively postponed this rule from taking effect for now. ○ However, the fear generated by this has already impacted our communities. Multnomah County has developed flyers to explain what public charge is, who it could impact and who it would not, and resources. This flyer has been translated in 5 other languages. Hard copies available and electronic copies will be emailed out with minutes. Providers are encouraged to post these in their waiting rooms and agencies
