

# MULTNOMAH COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE

## RULES OF CONDUCT

1. Persons entering this building are subject to a search of their person and any hand carried items.
2. Face coverings (face mask or shield) are required.
3. Entry to non-public areas must be approved by Multnomah County Elections (MCE) office staff.
4. Failure to comply with the above may result in exclusion from the MCE premises.
5. You are subject to exclusion from election property for:
  - Committing or attempting to commit any activity that would constitute a violation of any federal, state or local criminal statute or ordinance.
  - Fighting, threatening behavior, unreasonable noise, unsafe and/or disruptive behavior.
  - Being under the influence, possessing, selling, distributing or consuming any controlled substance or intoxicating liquor. Controlled substance is defined in ORS 475.005.
  - Disruption of the election, petition verification, or normal daily business processes.
  - Loitering or sleeping on the premises.
  - Vandalism, littering and/or damaging of MCE property.
  - Attempting to enter, entering, or being in non-public, confidential/private areas unescorted.
  - Smoking, vaping, or other use of tobacco in or on facility premises.
  - Bringing a bicycle or other similar devices into the building without authorization.
  - Introducing a weapon into the building.
  - Disregarding any reasonable request of MCE personnel or building security staff.
  - Interfering with the access or free passage of employees or visitors. Including, but not limited to, placing equipment or personal belongings in a manner that interferes with free passage.
  - Leaving personal belongings unattended.
  - Consuming food or drink in prohibited areas.
  - Bringing animals into the facility without approval of the Elections Director (with the exception of service animals).
  - Improperly using restrooms.
  - Engaging in sexual conduct, as defined under ORS 167.060.
  - Not wearing sufficient clothing.
