911 Ambulance Contract Response Time Performance Public Report

October 2018 - June 2024





One component of the Multnomah County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) system is ambulance services. Ambulance services are provided for all of Multnomah County by a single franchised ambulance service provider -- American Medical Response, Inc. (AMR). Response time goals are set by the contract for ambulance services. Response times are one of many contract requirements and are one way to measure compliance with the contract.

Response Time Goals

The response time goals differ based on geography and the presumed seriousness of the request when the ambulance is dispatched. The county's Ambulance Service Plan recognizes that response times will vary with these factors. To accommodate these differences, the contract sets a performance metric of meeting the response time expectation 80% or 90% of the time. This mirrors requirements by the state.

Geography

The County is divided into different geographical zones (See map on page 2.) Target response times are different for each zone.

 Urban or urban response zone means those areas in the Multnomah County Ambulance Service Area that are within the urban growth boundary. The urban area is divided into four smaller zones: North, South, East, and West.


- Rural or rural response zone means those areas in the Multnomah County Ambulance Service Area that are outside the urban growth boundary.
- Frontier means those areas within the rural response zone that the EMS Program Office deems exempt from the rural response time requirement because of extreme distance, inadequate roads, difficult terrain or other factors.

Presumed Seriousness of Request

There are multiple levels of presumed seriousness of requests coming in through 911. Two are recorded in these graphs. These include:


- Life threatening emergency A request for medical service that is known or likely to represent a medical condition that could result in death or severe disability, e.g., cardiac arrest, stroke, severe trauma. An ambulance responds to these calls with lights and a siren.
- Non-immediate 911 911 calls that are less serious, but need a response, e.g., general illness, isolated injury, falls with no other identified injury. An ambulance responds to these calls without the use of lights and a siren.

How to Read Response Time Performance Graphs





- **A.** The graph title includes information about the:
 - Response mode Life threatening or non-immediate which determine the time standard to be used
 - Geographic zone Urban (North, South, East, West Zones) or Rural
 - Date or time frame for the data
- **B.** The left side vertical axis (running from top to bottom of the graph) is the response volume (number of responses). This number is shown by the blue bars on the graph.
- **C.** The lower horizontal axis (running from left to right across the bottom of the graph) shows the time frame for reporting. This is either a month and year or a quarter and year, based on contract reporting time frames.
- **D.** The right side vertical axis (running from top to bottom of the graph) is the response compliance percentage. This percentage is shown by the orange line on the graph.
- **E.** The gray dashed reference line shows the response time compliance goals for each zone, either 80% or 90%.

The graphs on the following pages show the number of responses and the response time compliance rates by zone and presumed seriousness of the 911 request. Each graph covers the time from October 2018 through June 2024. Response time performance in the Urban zones is recorded by month. In the Rural zone, response time performance is recorded by quarter.


The data used to generate the graphs comes from EMS quality assurance data protected by Oregon Law (ORS 41.675-41.685). The data is processed and reviewed through FirstWatch Online Compliance Utility — a third party system required by contract and contracted for by AMR. The data is reviewed and approved by the EMS program staff. Responses have been corrected, and requested exemptions approved in accordance with the contract terms. Responses have also been deidentified and aggregated to ensure the privacy of the people who have used 911.


Urban Life Threatening and Non-Immediate Responses All Zones







Urban Life Threatening Response By Zone













Urban Non-Immediate Response by Zone











Rural Life Threatening and Non-Immediate Responses





Data Detail by Time Period

The tables on the following pages detail the information on the number of responses and the response time compliance rates by Urban zone and presumed seriousness of the 911 request.

These Urban zone tables are separated by year and month. The zones correspond to the geographic zones illustrated on page 2 of this report. Data for 2018 and 2024 are partially reported. The time period covered represents the data collected to date for the current contract period.

Because the detailed numbers of responses in the Rural zone are relatively small, they have been suppressed to protect the identities and confidentiality of those served and/or to prevent the backward calculation of other suppressed data. The Multnomah County Health Department is working on a way to share this detailed data without compromising confidentiality and data best practices.

Compliance rate information

The response time goals differ based on geography and the presumed seriousness of the request when the ambulance is dispatched. The county's Ambulance Service Plan recognizes that response times will vary with these factors.

The County's contract with AMR sets response time goals. Compliant calls meet all of the requirements in the contract for the response time for the zone and seriousness of the call, non-compliant calls did not meet those standards. Generally, target response times are 8 minutes or less for life threatening responses in Urban zones and 20 minutes or less for non-immediate responses in Urban zones. In the Rural zone, response time goals are 20 minutes or less for life threatening responses and 30 min or less for non-immediate responses. Sometimes the seriousness of a call is upgraded or downgraded during the call. This can affect the overall time allowed for compliance.

To reduce geographic inequity in response times throughout the Urban Response Area, the contract sets a performance measure of meeting the response time expectation 80% of the time in each of the Urban sub zones, and 90% of the time overall in Urban and Rural zones.
