The Multnomah County Auditor wants your input on the response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Auditor's Office is conducting an audit related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Your input is critical to our understanding of the efforts to ensure vital services, such as adult care homes, can continue safely and equitably during the pandemic.

> A survey will be coming via email in early September. Please keep a lookout for it.

The survey is anonymous so there will be no impact on your facility's license.

Training, Testing, and Events

Testing: Testing will be offered two times a week most weeks, and the capacity is limited to nine people. Everyone will be screened, kept six feet apart, and masks are required. Please contact us if there is a medical condition that does not allow you to wear a mask or if you don't have a mask. Find available dates here:

US Census Survey

The United States Census Bureau has started sending out census takers in person to visit homes that have not yet responded to the 2020 Census. This includes adult care homes.

All Census staff will have an official Census Bureau ID badge that includes their photograph, a US Department of Commerce watermark, and an expiration date. They are required to show this identification to you before they interview you. Census surveyors work between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.
