Explanation of Exceptions

→ Valid votes that have been marked by the voter outside the vote targets or using a marking device that cannot be read by the vote tally system shall not be included in making the determination whether the voting system has met the standard of acceptable performance for any precinct or ballot batch under ORS 254.529(7)(a) through (c) and are to be listed as exceptions.

All exceptions listed for the three contests above were correctly tallied by the tally system but there was variation in how the original adjudication board and the hand count board adjudicated the vote for the contest. The most common variation was ballots that were tallied by the tally system as write-in votes because the oval was filled in but there was either nothing written on the line or there was something other than a name written on the line like "none of the above" or "me". These exceptions were counted by the hand count boards as under votes as they should have been adjudicated by the tally system adjudication boards. This was most apparent in the judicial contest where there was only one candidate filed and many voters chose to write something on the line but in most cases it was not someone's name.

There were two errors that have been recorded in the counts above. Box AB-0320 and box AB-1052 both had one less ballot in the box than was counted by the tally system. Through examination of the ballot images we were able to determine that through scanner operator error, on these two boxes, one ballot had been scanned twice. This led to the total ballots counted in those two boxes by the hand count boards to be one less than the number of ballots scanned by the tally system.
