- Public Health Approach to Gun Violence Intervention
- Credible messengers provide intervention and support in communities to those at risk of involvement with gun violence
- Crisis Response and long-term stabilization



# Hospital-Based Violence Intervention Programs (HVIPs)

- Engage gunshot victims in hospital
- Continue services within victim's community
- Reduce likelihood of revictimization and retaliation
