Executive Summary: This is the annual update on Library work unit designations for purposes of lateral transfers under the AFSCME Local 88 contract, Article 22. The only change from FY14 is that the names of some work areas have been updated.

- Facilities
- Human Resources (Administrative Support Services, Employee Services, Learning Systems, Volunteer Services, Title Wave Book Store)

- Marketing + Online Engagement
- Technical Services (Selection and Acquisition, Cataloging, Processing)
 Note: Local 88 and the county have entered into a Memorandum of Exception regarding the Technical Services work unit designation whereby employees in Technical Services can exercise their seniority to lateral transfer into the Neighborhood Libraries, Central Library, Adult and Youth Services Divisions and Materials Movement work unit. However, Technical Services is considered a part of the Support Services work unit for the purposes of lateral transfers into Technical Services. The memorandum expires at the termination of the 2011-2014

Rationale and background: Article 22.VII.B. requires that management provide notice of designated work units on an annual basis. Under Article 22.III, employees have the right to transfer to positions they are qualified for within their classification on the basis of seniority.
