Comprising 330 feet south of the southeast corner of the northeast ¼ of the southwest ¼ of the northeast ¼ of Section 20, Township 1 South, Range 4 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence west 360 feet to the southwest corner of parcel of land conveyed to Donald Altman by deed recorded December 11, 1947 in Book 1220, page 96, Deed Records, for point of beginning; thence west 100 feet; thence north to the south line of Dodge Park Boulevard; thence easterly along said south line to northeast corner of said Altman land; thence south to point of beginning, in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon.
