Unfortunately, not everyone feels that same sense of accomplishment or satisfaction after a hard day's work. I am seeking to continue serving in Position 6 on the David Douglas school board because hard working families deserve hard working representatives, and just like I worked hard building decks and painting houses, I will continue to work hard advocating for student and worker rights, economic stability, and equitable education opportunities for all Oregonians. As the first and only person of color to ever serve on the DDSB, these commitments have also been demonstrated through my civic leadership, in addition to my professional political experience.
