### Amends County Charter; Limits Campaign Contributions, Expenditures; Communications Identify Funders.

**Question:** Should County Charter be amended to limit campaign contributions and expenditures and require that campaign communications identify major contributors?

**Summary:** Restricts contributions and expenditures to support or oppose candidates for public office in Multnomah County elections. Limits: contributions by individuals (\$500.00), political committees (\$500.00). Limits: independent expenditures to \$5,000.00 per year; candidate self-funding of campaigns. Prohibits loans by candidate. Requires group, association, or entity making an expenditure seeking to influence candidate election to register as political committee and requires name of political committee to clearly identify economic or other interests of dominant contributors. Allows formation of "Small Donor Committees" which may contribute all amounts received from individuals of \$100.00 or less per year. Requires that each communication to voters disclose names of all political committees and entities, their funders, including the top five dominant contributors or spenders and their businesses. Requires both printed and online voter's pamphlet to include list of 5 dominant contributors for each candidate identified by name, type of business from which each contributor obtained majority of income, amount contributed to candidate. Administered; enforced by County Auditor. Provides penalties if violated. Allows for adjustments; severability if constitutional challenge successful.

Instructions for Circulators

- 1 Only active registered voters of the county, city or district may sign the petition.
  - 2 Have signers use a pen when signing petitions. Use a pen when you are certifying petitions.
  - 3 Only one circulator may collect signatures on any one signature sheet of the petition.
  - 4 You must personally witness all signatures you collect and you should not collect additional signatures on the petition sheet once you have signed and dated the circulator certification.
  - 5 It is against the law for circulators to:
    - Circulate a petition containing a false signature.
    - Make false statements to any person who signs the petition or requests information about it.
    - Attempt to obtain the signature of a person who is not qualified to sign the petition.
    - Offer money or anything of value to another person to sign or not sign the petition.
    - Sell or offer to sell signature sheets.
    - Write, alter, correct, clarify or obscure any information about the signers unless the signer is disabled and requests assistance or the signer initials after the changes are made.
    - Accept compensation to circulate a petition that is based on the number of signatures obtained.
- Warning** Violations of the circulator requirements may result in conviction of a felony with a fine of up to \$125,000 and/or prison for up to 5 years.

Instructions for Signers

- 1 Only active Oregon voters may sign the petition. Sign your full name, as you did when you registered to vote.
- 2 Fill in the date you signed the petition, your printed name and residence address in the spaces provided. Only you may complete your optional information.
- 3 Initial any changes the circulator makes to your printed name, residence address or date you signed the petition.
- 4 Use a pen when signing the petition.
- 5 It is against the law for signers to:
  - Sign another person's name under any circumstances.
  - Sign a petition more than one time.
  - Sign a petition when you are not qualified to sign it.

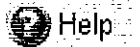
