

MAR 2023	<b>Evaluation Phase I</b> Did the community workshops education influence decision to apply? Survey attendees and previously contracted community partners, analyze survey results (gap analysis), re-engage regarding results, inform application questions
APR 2023	<b>Pre-Application Phase</b> Application question writing, Panel Members Identified
MAY 2023	<b>Application Phase</b> Release RFPQ, Application to RFPQ open




JUL 2023	<b>Post-Application Phase</b> Close Application
JUL 2023	<b>Evaluation Phase II</b> Engage Panels, Review Proposals, Score Applications, Notify qualified/selected Community Partners, begin allocation phase (funding needed?)
SEP 2023	<b>Contracting Phase</b> Leadership and Program Manager conduct budget review, Community Partner Engagement contract negotiations, Remove barriers to contracting (invoicing/staff support), confirm program models/services
OCT 2023	<b>Evaluation Phase III</b> Was the application period helpful? What demographics were reached? Survey contracted community partners, ingest survey results, analyze survey results (gap analysis), re-engage regarding results, inform application questions
DEC 2023	<b>Stabilization Phase</b> Mega RFPQ project complete, Community Services' project goals accomplished, Data Validation

# Key terms in this presentation

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RFPQ - Request For Programmatic Qualifications (Proposals).

“Mega RFPQ” - our nickname for the funding event: Community Services for Older Adults.

Culturally Specific - Agencies that provide services for specific populations to create an environment of belonging and safety in which services are delivered.

Culturally Responsive - Services provided in a way that is culturally responsive to the varied and intersecting identities of older adults and people with disabilities.

# Of Importance about the RFPQ

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- The RFPQ awards contracts to community organizations to deliver Older Americans Act Services for people 60+ in Multnomah County and other service for adults who are family caregivers and adults with disabilities
