Derelict schoolhouse gets artistic remodeling

Glass craftsmen Tim and Gail O'Neill have solved both their housing and studio needs by buying and renovating a spacious old schoolhouse in East Multnomah County.

A former gymnasium is now a living room and bedrooms for the O'Neills and their children Tammy, 17, Sean, 13, and Erin, 10.

Studios for Mrs. O'Neill and two potters who are renting have been created from an auditorium (which still has a ticket window).

The studio where O'Neill now does his own work in stained glass and executes designs by other glass artists still has the expanse of windows and blackboards it did when it functioned as a first-grade classroom.
