The following measures were referred by the City of Portland Charter Commission for the November 5, 2024 General Election ballot and were previously submitted to, and numbered by, Multnomah County Elections Division:

Measure 26-249

<u>Ballot Title Caption</u>: Amends Charter: Deletes outdated, redundant requirements to approve utility franchises.

Measure 26-250

<u>Ballot Title Caption</u>: Amends Charter: Adds Independent Portland Elections Commission.

Measure 26-251

<u>Ballot Title Caption</u>: Amends Charter: Updates authority to manage parks, sewers and stormwaters.

Measure 26-252

<u>Ballot Title Caption</u>: Amends Charter: Deletes vague, archaic and inconsistent language.

Measure 26-253

<u>Ballot Title Caption</u>: Amends Charter: Removes citywide vote requirement for mandatory building weatherization.

IMPORANT NOTE: In accordance with Portland City Code Section 2.04.140 E., each Charter Commission referred measure must be designated on the ballot as, "Referred to the People by the Charter Commission."
