How the program works:

Direct Family Support

Our Family Support Specialist connects with families through personal check-ins and family gatherings:

- Connect & Play Circles offer families a culturally safe and developmentally nurturing space to explore, create, build community, and directly get connected to community providers.
- Virtual Caregiver Support Circles allow parents and caregivers to make meaningful connections and uplift each other to build stronger community relationships.

We emphasize culturally specific approaches and lead with the understanding that traditional knowledge = best practice.

Resource Connections


