<p>Review Agenda & Approve Minutes Olivia reviewed the agenda. The committee approved the meeting minutes from May and July by consensus.</p>	
<p>Introductions & Team Agreements Olivia reviewed the team agreements and asked members to introduce themselves, their pronouns, their favorite fall activity and a team agreement they would like to focus on for the meeting.</p>	
<p>Equity, Policy & Its Impacts Olivia introduced Daniel Garcia from the Office of Diversity & Equity. Daniel reviewed the goals for his discussion, and then asked members to engage in an activity identifying defining personal experiences. He then asked members to think about a value that they took away from each experience. Members then paired up and shared with each other. Daniel invited a few members to share their story with the group.</p> <p>Daniel reviewed the concept of cultural humility and asked the group how they already practice it.</p>	

<p>Daniel reviewed the Triangle/Levels of Inequity/Equity and screened the video: Race - The Power of an Illusion: The House We Live In. He asked members to split into groups of four and to discuss how individual, institutional and systemic inequity showed up. Groups shared out.</p> <p>Daniel reviewed the institutional and systemic history of Oregon and people, place, power and process.</p> <p>Daniel screened a second video - The House We Live in Today. Daniel asked the group to consider going forward: where are the areas in which these concepts can show up in the work that the CIC is going to do together?</p>
