Dear Ms. Rossolo:

Based upon the Stipulated Order signed by Judge Waller on January 7, 2014, allowing circulation of the prospective petition for referendum you filed on December 23, 2013, pending resolution of your appeal of my Determination that the prospective petition does not meet constitutional requirements, we have reviewed your referendum petition paperwork, as to meeting the requirements to collect signatures, and have found it to be in order. For this purpose, we have assigned the prospective petition Referendum MultCoRef-01. You may begin collecting signatures for Ref-01.

You are required to use the approved SEL 373 form, cover sheet with chief petitioner name and address and the text of ordinance.

Each circulator must have a copy of the text available for review by petition signers. If you intend to mail the petition you must include a copy of the text with each mailing. A copy of the text must also be provided with every electronic signature sheet.

If the Multnomah County Circuit Court determines that the prospective petition meets constitutional requirements, you will need to collect a minimum of 11,234 signatures from registered voters in Multnomah County. The deadline to submit petition signatures for verification is March 19, 2014.
