Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement comment period closes next Monday, June 13

The 45-day comment period for the Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (SDEIS) will close next Monday, June 13, 2022 at midnight. As a reminder, the SDEIS documents refinements to the original Preferred Alternative from the Draft EIS which will reduce overall project costs and help ensure the project is more likely to be funded and built.

Your comments will help the project team ensure all the appropriate analysis is conducted and documented in the Final EIS for approval in December 2022.
