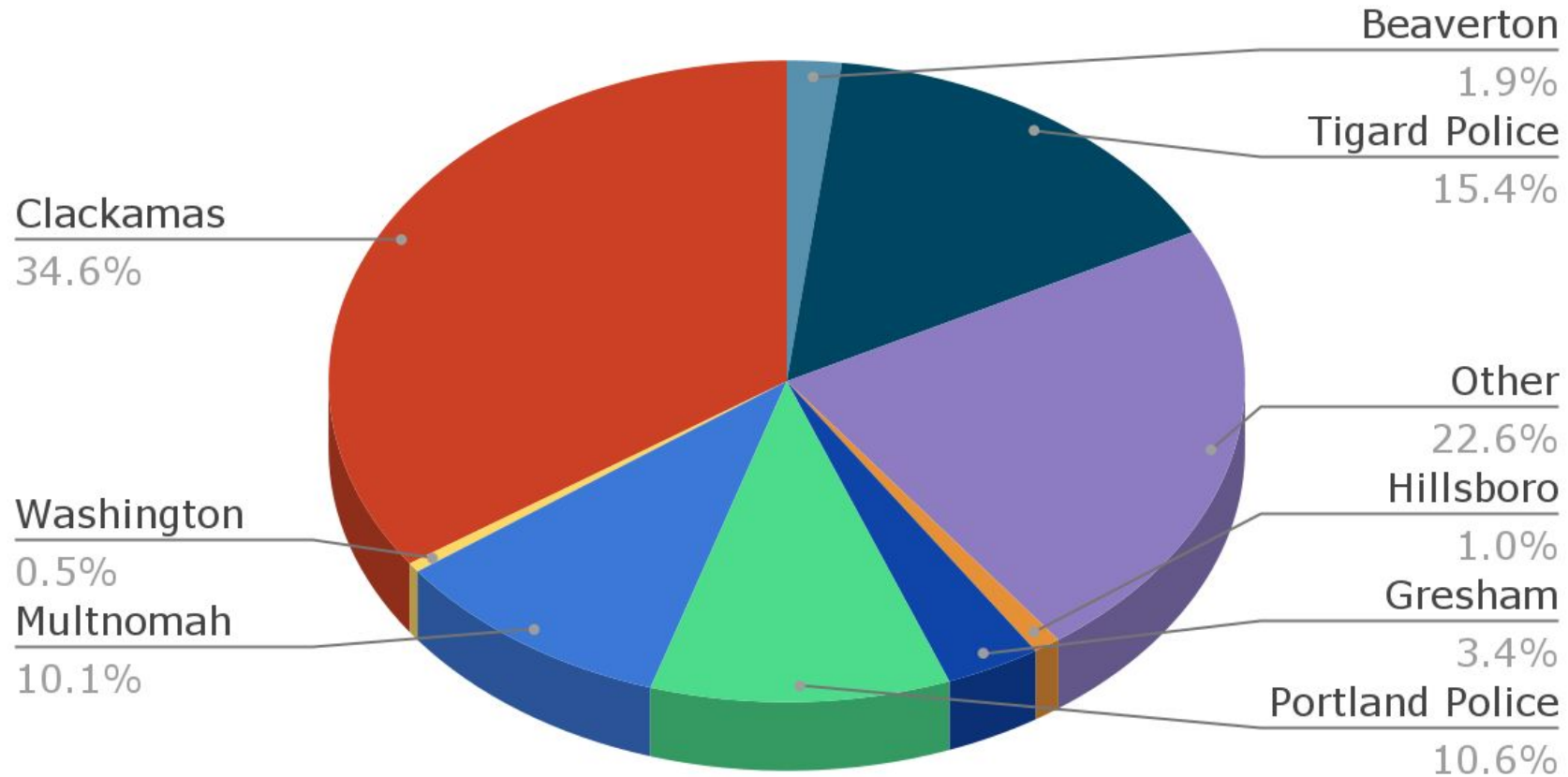

*The referral source indicates the location where youth are in contact with the criminal justice system. If the youth provides a Multnomah County address, they are referred to the Multnomah County DCJ CHI-EI program.

26 youth actively engaged

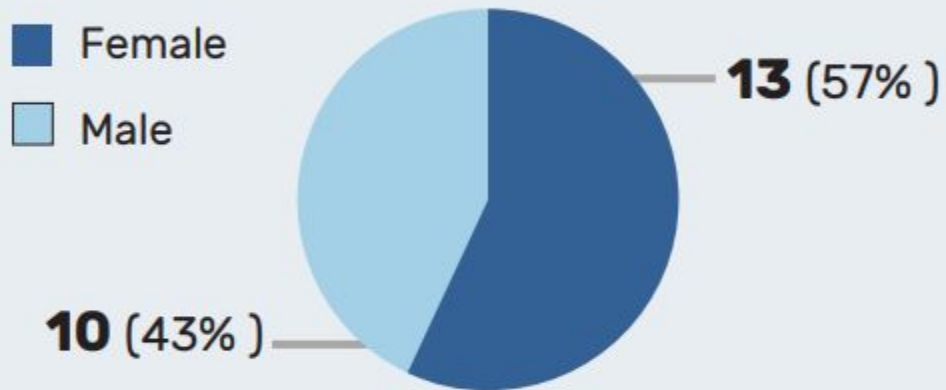
7 youth successfully completed

Note: While some youth may have been referred to the program in prior years, this data indicates the current number of youth actively engaged.

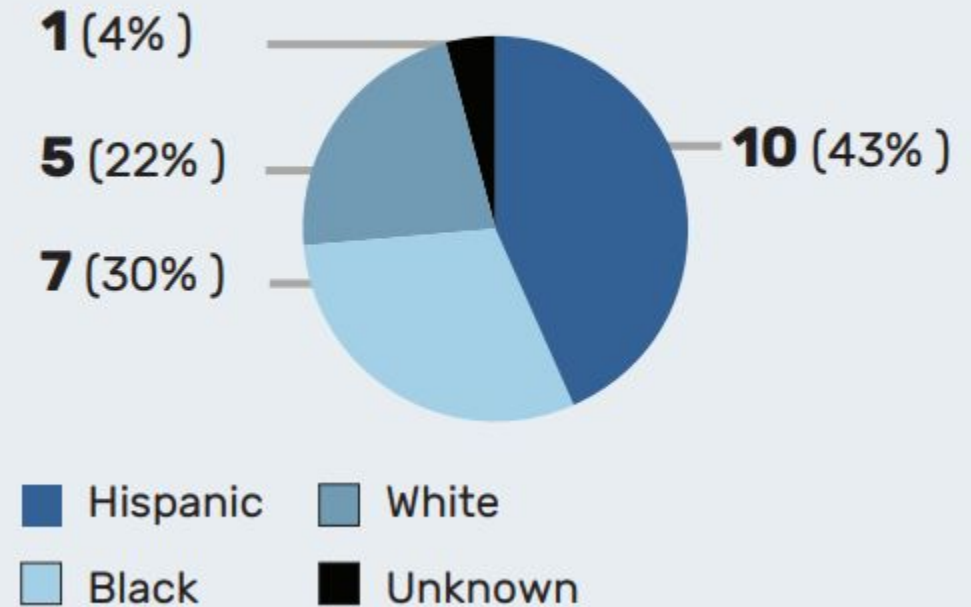
CHI - Early Intervention Engagement

Gender of Participants (n=23)



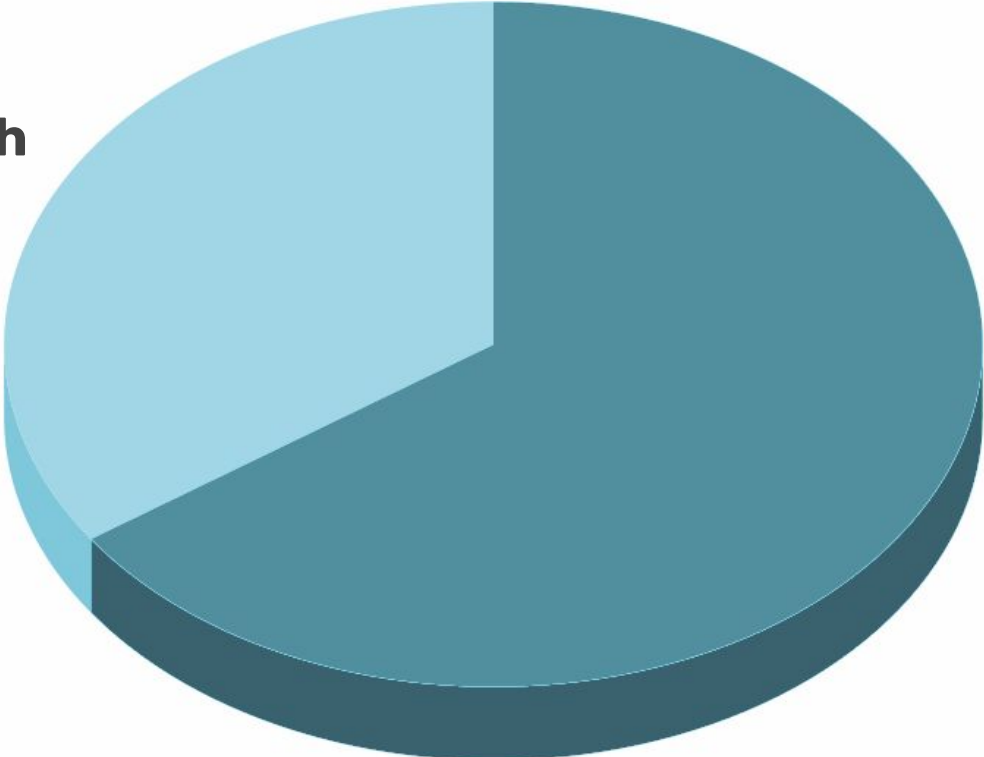
Race of Participants (n=23)

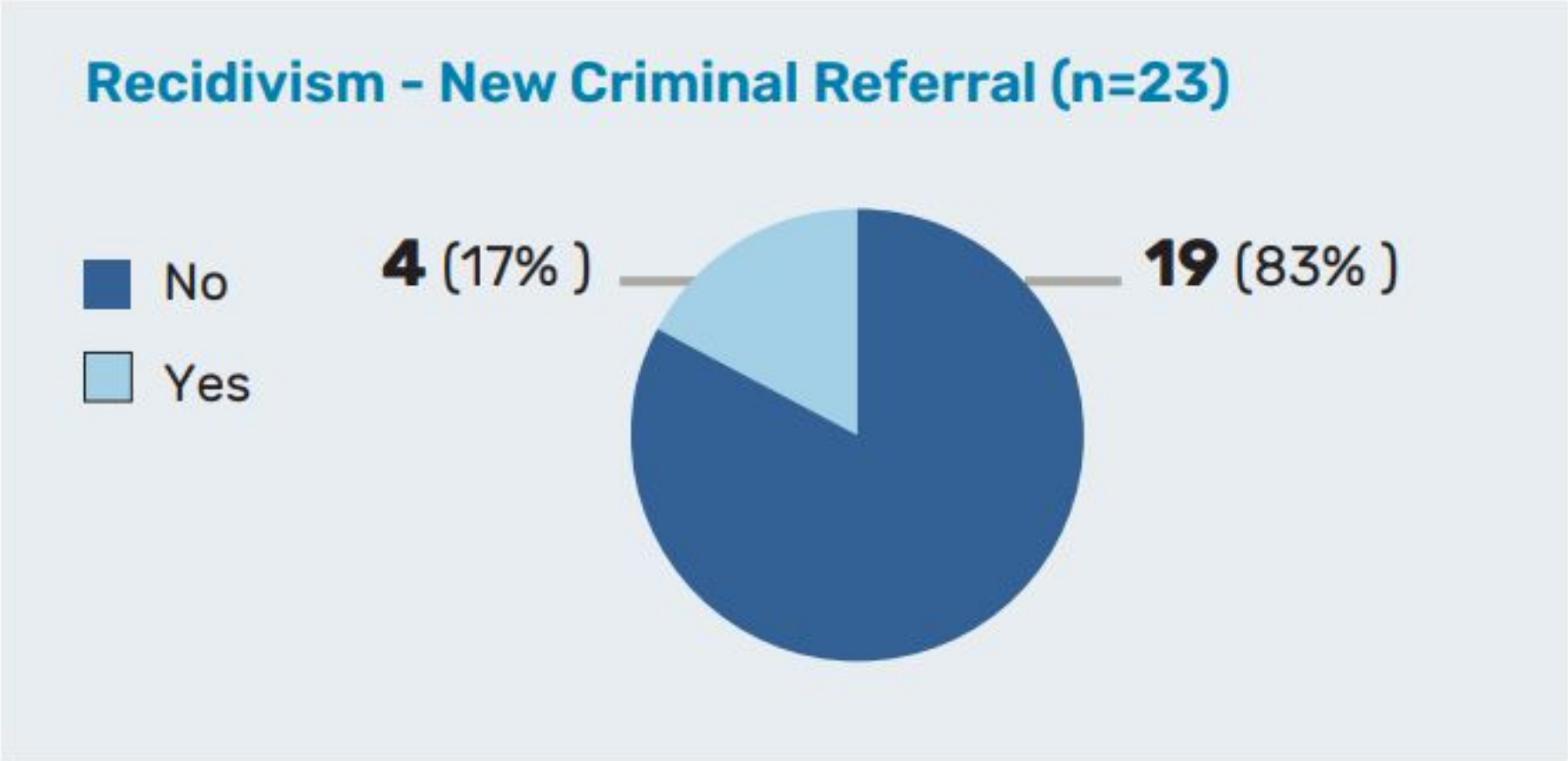
