 - MUST READ Equipment is limited to Apple iPad, iPad Mini, apps, and cases. (EXCEPTION: MacBook Air laptops and software are available to children over 12 for whom a tablet does not meet the educational need.)

Equipment comes with a warranty and a protective case. All applicants get the same version of the equipment and cases. No phones or cellular-enabled devices are purchased (wifi only).

- Family members may not apply on behalf of their own children.

 Application must be made by someone who works with the child in a professional capacity (e.g. teacher, educational service provider, disability service provider, health care provider, etc.).
- The intent of this charitable gift fund is to help low-income Oregon children with special health needs succeed in school. OCCYSHN uses the funds to buy educational equipment for children who meet the criteria.
- Oregon children age 3-21 years qualify if they have a diagnosed disability or special health need which impacts their education. The child must be enrolled in school, Early Childhood Special Education, or other preschool.
