Hi,

It seems like the project in August 2023 is being re-discussed or resubmitted by a new group. I notice that this time notification documents lack some details compared with the previous one and I believe this may be intentional.

If there is any new resident who moved in since fall 2023, they may have no clear idea about what this is about and what assessment was already performed.

Regardless, my 2 year old questions were not answered previously, so I just reiterate:

Q1: **Which MCC is articulating that >750 ft is a safe zone?** This was notified for the parties within 750ft. I believe public playgrounds for kids are nearby.

Q2: Although this facility is constructed in Multnomah county, its impact will be on Washington county as well in the future. **What is Oregon law across two counties for exclusive farm use (so I assume this is NOT for the public in Oregon state) that requires any assessment report or safe level audit before this application and the last minute notification**, rather after construction? I don't expect most residents with lack of technical information/knowledge on RF/EM hazard to argue about anything.
