Dear Land Use Planner,

As a resident in Bethany Creek Falls, I am adamantly opposed to a cell tower in our neighborhood. The proposed tower at 13937 & 14111 NW Springville Rd, Portland (Case Number: T2-2025-0023) poses significant environmental concerns. Cell towers should never be located next to dense neighborhoods, playgrounds or schools. It is not safe. We shouldn't be risking our health and/or lives!!

Low intensity RF radiation is a hazard to all of us, and especially to the children. FCC's limit was set decades ago when cell phones and towers were uncommon. Science is revealing harm to all living organisms from RFR exposure with levels at or below current U.S. safety guidelines. FCC guidelines need to change but we can't wait for years until the FCC updates their standards. We should be taking precautions, not risks. Therefore, I am adamantly opposed to having this tower in our neighborhood.

- There is sufficient scientific data about the biological effects of electromagnetic field (EMF), and in particular about radiofrequency radiation (RFR).
- Our federal FCC regulations (1996 Telecommunications Act) allow cell towers to be near dense neighborhoods without sufficient setback.
- RF radiation is a class 2B possible carcinogen.
- There have been NO studies proving that long-term exposure to RF radiation/5G is safe.
- **What is the solution? DENY THIS CELL TOWER APPLICATION IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD.**

Potential dangers of long-term exposure to 5G signals on the individuals (especially children) or environment are not fully understood. It is not smart to have cell towers located next to dense neighborhoods, playgrounds or schools. We shouldn't be risking our health and/or lives!!
