Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to formally express our profound concerns and strong opposition to the proposed installation of a wireless facility (cell tower) at the planned location near Forest Park, a residential area, and a public playground. This location is also a vital wildlife habitat, and we foresee significant environmental impacts and public safety hazards should this construction proceed.

Our primary objections are based on the following critical points:

- 1. Increased Wildfire Risk:** The geographical location is highly susceptible to strong winds, particularly from fall through spring. The presence of a tall cell tower in close proximity to Forest Park, combined with these high wind conditions, significantly elevates the risk of wildfire. This poses an unacceptable danger to the integrity of the forest park itself and, critically, to the safety and property of residents in the adjacent residential area.
- 2. While acknowledging varying perspectives on health impacts, the visual blight and potential perceived risks alone are detrimental to the quality of life in our neighborhood.
