

D3 Amendment to the Climate Justice Plan - If Moyer Amendment Passes

Aug. 27, 2026

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. To adopt the 2026 Multnomah County Climate Justice Plan (CJP).
2. To support a One-County approach to implementing the County Strategies identified in the CJP.
3. The Board requests that the Office of Sustainability participate in a Board work session at the beginning of each fiscal year, in which the Board will identify annual prioritized strategies for the Office of Sustainability to pursue.
4. To support the Office of Sustainability in advancing and coordinating implementation of the CJP, including providing regular reports that include and cost estimates and workforce impact analyses of new, prioritized strategies to the Board of County Commissioners in advance of implementation for Board approval.
5. To support ongoing engagement with frontline communities and other interest holders for continuous input on the implementation of the CJP.
6. To adopt the goal of reducing community-wide carbon emissions to 50% below 1990 levels by 2030, and achieving net-zero community-wide greenhouse gas emissions levels by 2050.
