Housing and Homelessness

- Build a pathway to ownership using land trusts and savings accounts
- Improve processes to prioritize affordable housing development
- Lobby to lift state preemption on rent control, inclusionary zoning

Expanding Services Across Portland

- Bring all neighborhoods up to basic standards with sidewalks and bike lanes
- Repair city streets and begin addressing ongoing deficiencies in maintenance
- Expand park access and connectivity by completing a citywide trail network
- Promote equity in technology access by building a municipal fiber optic network

- Promote investment of City funds in Portland by creating a public bank

Environment

- Promote greener buildings, solar energy & efficiency
- Create local air pollution authority

Public Safety

- Rebuild trust in Police by reforming policies to promote equity in enforcement
- Engage with Black Lives Matter and other social justice movements to ensure that community needs are addressed in a timely and comprehensive manner

Integrity and Independence

We must not let wealthy donors pre-select our leaders. Stand with me and take the bold position that we can do better. Seize this opportunity to shape a brighter future with me.
