Twice-monthly Data Snapshot

For the Reporting Period of Nov. 1-15, 2024

The following includes two data sets: Cumulative data collected from **Sept. 1 to Nov. 15, 2024**, and data for the current reporting period of **Nov. 1 to Nov. 15, 2024**. Multnomah County is sharing the following schedule for future data releases. This schedule allows for a larger sample size and takes into account lags in completion data. The first quarterly report that will include deflection completion data will be released in mid-Feb. 2025 to ensure the sample size is large enough to reflect possible trends, issues or adjustments needed. The schedule will be as follows:

- **Twice-monthly snapshot** with data on number of referrals, number of deflections initiated, referring partners and more. This report includes a two-week lag to analyze and verify data. Data will include the first through the 15th of the month, then the 16th through the last day of the month.
- **Quarterly update** with at least a 1.5-month lag to account for 30 days to complete deflection and up to 30 days for providers to report what services were accessed (outcome, transportation, demographics, etc.) The first quarterly update will be released in mid-Feb. 2025 and will include Sept.–Dec. 2024 data.
- **Yearly report** that will include Q4 2024-Q3 2025 data and analysis and will be released in winter 2025.

We are also working to create a public dashboard, but the bi-weekly reports can be found [at this website](#) for the time being. The next twice-monthly data release will include data from Nov. 16-30, 2024.
