## **Coordinated Entry – Janus Youth Programs** Access Center (503) 432-3986, 24/7 coordinated access & safety off the streets

- Self referral, street outreach & referrals from youth, child welfare, juvenile justice, education, community
- Mobile access for youth throughout the community by screening staff
- · Single screening to determine eligibility and vulnerability
- Single HMIS record created at screening
- Referral to appropriate services within the HYC with warm hand-off & outside of HYC
