Nicholas Alberts is not currently certified as a police officer by the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training. If elected or appointed, Mr. Alberts will need to become basic police certified within one year of taking office and a copy of the certification would need to be filed with the county clerk. The governing body shall declare the office of sheriff vacant if the Sheriff is not certified as a police officer within one year.
