The governing body shall declare the office of sheriff vacant if the Sheriff is not certified as a police officer within one year.

A copy of the certification shall be filed with the county clerk or the county official in charge of elections. The county governing body shall declare the office of sheriff vacant when the person serving as sheriff is not certified as a police officer within one year ofter taking office.
