1. Welcome

Vince Jones-Dixon opened the meeting, welcoming everyone and noting Trini's opening remarks. (00:00:02 - 00:00:17)

2. Opportunity for Public Comment

3. Review and Adoption of May 12, 2025 Meeting Minutes

4. Safety Update - MaryJo Andersen, Multnomah County - Information/Discussion Item
